

REVIVE A SUNNAH TODAY

Why should you revive a Sunnah?

1. To be in Paradise with the Prophet. Whoever revives my sunnah then he has loved me. And whoever loved me, he shall be with me in Paradise [At-Tirmidhee]
2. To build up many rewards. Whoever revives a Sunnah from my Sunnah and the people practice it, will have the same reward of those who practice it without their reward diminishing [Ibn Maajah]

	<p>Reciting one AYAH</p> <p>The Messenger of Allah sal Allahu alayhi wa sallam said: Whoever recites ayat ul-Kursi immediately after each prescribed prayer, there will be nothing standing between him and his entering Paradise except death. [An-Nasaa', Ibn Hibbaan]</p>		<p>Move it ...after prayer!</p> <p>The Prophet ordered us to separate between prayers. One prayer mustn't be joined with another until you speak or exit [Muslim]. Ibn Taymiyyah said: he (salallahu alayhi wa sallam) prohibited that any [obligatory] salah be followed immediately by [optional] one; one should separate between them with speech or changing one's place.</p>
	<p>THE DHIKR</p> <p>The Prophet said: There are two qualities, no Muslim man acquires them but he will enter Paradise, and they are simple and easy. He should glorify Allaah (subhanAllah) ten times immediately after each prayer, and praise Him (alhamdulillah) ten times and magnify Him (Allahu akbar) ten times. [At-Tirmidhee, 3332]</p>		<p>READ AND RISE</p> <p>Abu Hurayrah reported that the prophet recited in the two sunnah rak'ah of the fajr prayer Surah Al Kafiroon (in the first rak'ah), and Surah Al Ikhlās (in the second rak'ah) [Muslim]. And narrated Abdullah Ibn Mas'ud [radiyallahu 'anhu]: I cannot count how many times I heard the Messenger of Allah recite, in the two rak'ah after maghrib and in the two rak'ah before fajr 'Say: O disbelievers, (Surah al Kafiroon) and 'Say: He is Allah, the One' (Surah al Ikhlās). [Ibn Majah, At-Tirmidhee]</p>
	<p>After ruku'</p> <p>Say 'sami Allahu lhamdahu' – Allah hears the one who praises Him. Rabbanaa wa lakal hamd, hamdan katheeran tayyiban mubaarakan feeh -Our Lord, all praise is due only to You, praise which is abundant, excellent and blessed. Say this to make the angels race!</p>		<p>SAY SALAAM when you come home!</p> <p>Anas ibn Maalik radiyallahu anhu said: The Messenger of Allah salallahu alayhi wa sallam said to me: O my son, when you enter upon your family and say salaam, it will be a blessing for you and the members of your household. [At-Tirmidhee, declared hasan by shaykh al-Albani]</p>
	<p>LICK those fingers!</p> <p>The Prophet commanded people to lick their fingers and clean the plate, saying: "You do not know where the blessing lies". [Muslim] In one variant: "When one of you drops a morsel of food, he should pick it up, remove any dirt on it and then eat it, not leaving it for Shaytan. He should not wipe his hand with a cloth until he has licked his fingers. He does not know in which part of his food the blessing lies."</p>		<p>SHAKE, SHAKE...HANDS!</p> <p>The Prophet salallahu 'alayhi wa sallam said: "There are no two Muslims who meet and shake hands with one another, but they will be forgiven before they part [Abu Dawood] and... their sins will fall like the leaves of a tree" [At-Tabarani]</p>
	<p>LOVE For the sake of Allah!</p> <p>The Prophet s said: If any of you loves his brother then he should inform him [At-Tirmidhee] Uhibbuka fil-laahi (or to a female: uhibbukhi fil-laahi), "I love you for the sake of Allah". And if someone tells you, respond with Ahabbak-illadhee ahbabtane lah (for a male) Ahabakk-illadhee ahbabtinee lah (for a female), may the One for whom you have loved me love you, in return. [Abu Dawood]</p>		<p>What do you say when you trip? Bismillah!</p> <p>Abu Al-Malih narrated that a man said: I was riding behind the Prophet sallallahu alayhi wa sallam and his mount stumbled. I said: May the shaytan perish! The Prophet said: Do not say: May the shaytan perish, because when you say that he swells up so much that he becomes like a house and says: By my power. Rather say: bismillah, for if you say that the shaytan shrinks until he becomes like a fly. [Abu Dawud, Ahmad]</p>
	<p>Clean those teeth and please Allah!</p> <p>The Prophet salallahu 'alayhi wa sallam said: Siwaak cleanses the mouth and pleases the Lord. [Al-Bukhaari] And: Were it not for the fact that I did not want to make things too hard for my ummah, I would have commanded them to use the Siwaak at every time of prayer. [Al-Bukhaari]</p>		<p>Eat, SUPPLICATE, and get your sins forgiven!</p> <p>The Prophet, salallahu 'alayhi wa sallam, said: "He who has taken food and says at the end: Alhamdu lillahi-lladhee at'amani haadha, wa razaqneehi min ghairi hawli minnee wa laa quwwah— All praise is due to Allah Who has given me food to eat and provided it without any endeavour on my part or any power— all his past sins will be forgiven." [At-Tirmidhee]</p>
