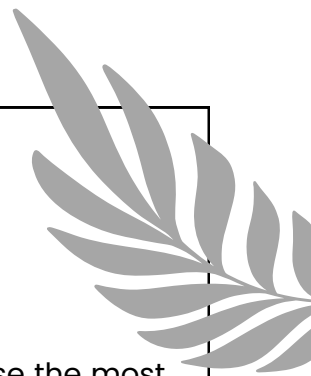


10 Simple Deeds for Paradise

(by Allah's Will)



1. Make dua' for taqwa & good manners.

The Prophet ﷺ was asked about that for which people are admitted into Paradise the most, so he said: Taqwa of Allah, and good character. And: Worship Ar-Rahman, feed others, spread the (greeting of) salam, then you will enter Paradise in security. [At-Tirmidhi]

And the Prophet ﷺ said: I guarantee a house in Jannah for one who gives up arguing, even if he is in the right; and I guarantee a home in the middle of Jannah for one who abandons lying even for the sake of fun; and I guarantee a house in the highest part of Jannah for one who has good manners. [Abu Dawud]

Dua' tip: Combine it all in this supplication!

اللَّهُمَّ إِنِّي أَسْأَلُكَ الْهُدَىٰ وَالْتَّقَىٰ وَالْعَقَافَ وَالْغِنَىٰ

Allahumma innee as'alukal hudaa wat-tuqaa wal 'afaafa wal ghinaa

O Allah, I ask you for guidance, righteousness, chastity, and independence. (Muslim)

2. Pray 12 sunnah rakah.

The Prophet ﷺ said: *Whoever prays 12 rak'ah in the day and night, a house in Jannah will be built for him.* [Sunan an-Nasa'i] (2 rakah before Fajr, 4 before & 2 after dhohr, 2 after maghrib, 2 after 'isha).

3. Read Surah Al-Ikhlās.

The Prophet ﷺ said: *Whoever recites Qul huwa Allahu ahad ten times, Allah will build for him a house in Paradise.* [Sahih al-Jami' al-Saghir] The more you recite it, the better!

4. Remove an obstacle from the road.

Abu Huraira reported Allah's Messenger ﷺ as saying that he saw a person enjoying himself in Paradise because of the tree that he cut from the path which was a source of inconvenience to the people. [Muslim] Make it a habit to remove obstacles from the road, according to your ability.

5. Say laa ilaaha illAllah.

The Messenger of Allah ﷺ said: *He whose last words are: 'Laa ilaaha illAllah' (There is no true god except Allah) will enter Jannah.* [Abu Dawud] Increase in saying it!

6. Say this dhikr to be of the people of Paradise.

The Prophet Muhammad ﷺ said: *If somebody recites this invocation during the day, and if he should die then, he will be from the people of Jannah. And if he recites it in the night, and if he should die on the same day, he will be from the people of Jannah.* [Jami' at-Tirmidhi]

اللَّهُمَّ أَنْتَ رَبِّي لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا أَنْتَ خَلَقْتَنِي وَأَنَا عَبْدُكَ وَأَنَا عَلَىٰ عَهْدِكَ وَوَعْدِكَ مَا اسْتِطَعْتُ أَعُوذُ بِكَ مِنْ شَرِّ مَا بَخَسْتَنِي وَأَبُوءُ
إِلَيْكَ بِبِعْمَتِكَ عَلَيَّ وَأَعْتَرِفُ بِذُنُوبِي فَأَعْفِرْ لِي ذُنُوبِي إِنَّهُ لَا يَغْفِرُ الذُّنُوبَ إِلَّا أَنْتَ

Allāhumma anta rabbī lā ilāha illā anta, khalaqtanī wa ana `abduka, wa ana `alā `ahdika wa wa`dika ma-ṣtaṭa`tu. A`ūdhu bika min sharri ma ṣana`tu, wa abū`u ilayka binīmatika `alayya wa a`tarifu bidhunūbī faghfirli dhunūbī innahu lā yaghfirudh-dhunūba illā ant

O Allah, You are my Lord, none has the right to be worshipped except You, You created me and I am Your servant and I abide to Your covenant and promise as best I can, I take refuge in You from the evil of which I committed. I acknowledge Your favor upon me and I acknowledge my sin, so forgive me, for verily none can forgive sin except You.

7. Say you're pleased with Allah, Islam and the Prophet ﷺ

The Prophet ﷺ said: Whoever says: رَضِيْتُ بِاللَّهِ رَبًّا وَبِالْإِسْلَامِ دِينًا وَبِمُحَمَّدٍ رَسُولًا - radheetu billahi rabba, wa bil islaami deena, wa bi muhammadin rasoola - *I am pleased with Allah as my Rabb, and with Islam as my Deen, and with Muhammad as messenger, Jannah would be mandatory for him.* [Abu Dawud]

8. Say subhanAllah wal hamdulillah wa la ilaaha ilAllah wAllahu Akbar.

The Prophet ﷺ said: *I met Ibrahim on the Night of Ascension (Al-Asra), and he said to me: 'O Muhammad, convey my greetings to your Ummah, and tell them that Jannah has a vast plain of pure soil and sweet water. It is a plain levelled land. The plants grow there by uttering: Subhan-Allah, Al-hamdu lillah, La ilaha illallah and Allahu Akbar (Allah is free from imperfection; praise be to Allah; there is no true god except Allah; and Allah is Greatest).* [At- Tirmidhi]. Use it all day; while working, surfing the internet etc.

9. Daily ask 3 times for Jannah & to be protected from the Fire.

Have Paradise & the Fire supplicate for you! The Prophet ﷺ said: *Whoever asks for Paradise, three times, Paradise will say: "O Allah, admit him to Paradise." And whoever asked to be saved from Hell, three times, Hell will say: "O Allah, save him from Hell.* [Ibn Majah] You can say: اللَّهُمَّ إِنِّي أَسْأَلُكَ الْجَنَّةَ وَأَعُوذُ بِكَ مِنَ النَّارِ - Allahuma innee as'alukal jannah, wa a'oodhu bika minan-naar - O Allah , verily I ask You for Paradise and I seek refuge in You from the Fire (three times).

10. Pray 2 rak'ah after wudhu.

The Messenger of Allah ﷺ said: *Any one performs ablution and performs the ablution perfectly and then offers two rak'ahs of prayers concentrating on them with his heart and face but paradise will necessarily fall to his lot.* [Abu Dawud]
